

Athletic or Extracurricular Event Expectations



Transportation

Students that are attending any Athletic or Extracurricular event are responsible for their own transportation and may at NO TIME ride the athletic team bus to or from an event.

Conduct at Events

All Health Sciences Charter School students, their parents / guardians, and family members of students who attend our school are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful, responsible, and safe manner at all athletic / extracurricular events. All attendees are additionally expected to:

- ✓ Remain seated in our school's student-athlete support area
- ✓ Never demonstrate behaviors that will impact or interfere with the integrity of the game / event
- ✓ Avoid using inappropriate or vulgar language and refrain from making offensive gestures to officials, student-athletes or coaching staff from the opposing team, and/or their supporters
- ✓ Support our student-athletes, coaches, and staff members at all times
- ✓ Dispose of all trash in the appropriate areas of the building / athletic facility
- ✓ Leave the contest / event in a timely manner in an orderly fashion

Reporting an Incident

Students who attend Health Sciences Charter School have a personal responsibility to report any/all incidents to appropriate school personnel at any athletic or extracurricular event. Failure to do so may result in being prohibited from attending future contests or events.

ANY STUDENT OR MEMBER OF OUR SCHOOL COMMUNITY WHO FAILS TO ADHERE TO THE ABOVE LISTED EXPECTATIONS WILL BE EXCLUDED FROM ALL FUTURE CONTESTS. ADDITIONALLY, STUDENTS MAY RECEIVE IN-SCHOOL CONSEQUENCES FOR DEMONSTRATING ANY BEHAVIOR THAT FAILS TO MEET THE STANDARDS THAT WE HAVE ESTABLISHED AS AN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION.
